VOLUNTEER UNIFORMS

- A light breakfast of yogurt, granola bars and fruit will be served daily.

VOLUNTEER PARKING INFO

We ask that volunteers arrive at least 30 minutes prior to their shift to check-in at volunteer headquarters.

- Volunteer parking at Elkhorn North High School which is located north of 180th and West Maple Road at 17800 George Miller Parkway.
- A shuttle will be running to and from The Club at Indian Creek and Elkhorn North High School.
- Volunteers will then walk from the parking lot to the Volunteer Headquarters.

GOLF CART SAFETY & ETIQUETTE

All volunteers must follow safety rules when operating carts

SAFETY RULES

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- No golf cart will be operated by an intoxicated person.
- Only authorized people may drive golf carts only operate a golf cart that has been assigned to you.
- Do not move golf cart until all occupants are seated.
- Prior to driving a golf cart, check to see if it is set to go forward or backward; make adjustments as necessary.
- Always drive wheels straight forward up and down a hill.
- Never make a sharp turn, even on a straight-away.
- Never stand up in a moving golf cart.
- Slow down and drive with extra caution when grass is wet.
- Set the parking brake before leaving the cart.
- Remove the keys when the golf cart is left unattended.
- Regularly use hand sanitizer while operating golf cart.
- Sanitize cart before and after your shift.

ETIQUETTE TIPS

- Kneel or sit when in front of a large gallery.
- Applaud good shots.
- Remain silent and still while golfers are hitting and in play.
- Respect all volunteers.
- The only time autographs are to be requested from professionals is after the pros' round of golf has been completed.

Cameras and radios are NOT permitted on the course at anytime during tournament play. Please silence cell phones. All unauthorized equipment will be confiscated.
